The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, and Mary Arganbright, County Clerk.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Kay.

The official minutes of March 28, 2011, were approved and signed.

Phil Aumick, Economic Development Director, stopped in and gave the commissioners an update. He inquired about the resolution he left that the county attorney needed to look over. The commissioners said that they hadn't done anything with it yet. Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 30, Ottawa County 5, and Saline County 1. The commissioners talked to Keith about the possibility of sharing an Emergency Management Coordinator with Saline County. Keith said that there are some aspects of the job that Saline County Emergency Management does not do, like GIS. They have a separate department that does that. The commissioners also talked to Keith about jail issues.

The commissioners signed Resolution 11-10, issuing a burn ban for Ottawa County, Kansas, for the next 7 days.
