Regular Session

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m., by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of October 13, 2008, were read, approved, and signed.

Commissioner Luthi signed the Cereal Malt Beverage License for Roger Miller, d/b/a Bohemian Hall, and the Notice to Township Board.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, talked to the board about legal matters. Commissioner McCullick moved to go into executive session for five minutes at 8:33 a.m. for attorney/client matters. Commissioner McGavran seconded. Motion carried. Those present were the commissioners, Bruce, and Mary Arganbright, County Clerk. They returned to regular session at 8:38 a.m. No decision was made.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, discussed roads and bridges of the county.

Ken White, County Sheriff, gave prisoner count of 15.

The commissioners interviewed applicants for the Emergency Management position.

Commissioner McGavran moved to include the Emergency Management Coordinator job to the county's Non-Regulated drug and alcohol testing policy. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried.
