The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of March 24, 2008, was read, approved, and signed.

Commissioner McGavran moved to establish newly elected base salaries at: County Commissioner, \$16,540; Full time County Attorney, \$46,000; County Clerk, \$27,000; County Treasurer, \$27,000; County Sheriff, \$30,000; and County Register of Deeds, \$25,000. If the County Attorney position becomes part-time, the salary will be negotiated. Salaries could be negotiated due to experience and certifications. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried. Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, reported that they are working on criminal and juvenile cases.

Sandy Cline, Health/Aging Department, gave the commissioners an update on Aging services. The transportation numbers are increasing. Sandy said they are really keeping busy with Hospice patients. Sandy said that they are getting the new mini-van sometime in June.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, gave the commissioners they requested on tire collection at the landfill.

Vouchers were approved.

Bobby Hudson, Minneapolis City Mayor, gave the commissioners a recycling center update.

Brian Kindall, Fair Board, Eldon Clark and Tania Daugherty, Minneapolis Recreation Commission, met with the commissioners to discuss the shooting of fireworks at the fairgrounds, and the mess that is left there, and the liability if someone gets hurt.

Ken White, County Sheriff, and Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, met with the board. Ken gave prisoner count of 38.
