

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of December 10, 2007, was read, approved, and signed.

Abatement's were approved.

Commissioner McGavran moved to give \$200 to Bennington After Prom. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, talked on legal matters. Truette McQueen, Zoning Administrator, joined the group. Commissioner McGavran moved to return Special Use Case SU-003-2007, to the planning and zoning board with the following requests: 1. Provide clarification and evidence related to the truck traffic referenced in the findings made by the planning and zoning board, 2. Provide clarification and evidence pertaining to the concerns related to potential fire issues, 3. Provide evidence pertaining to the availability of liability insurance provided by the applicant, 4. Provide evidence pertaining to whether or not the applicant is willing to have a sunset provision on this special use permit. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Luthi moved to retroactively pass the disaster Resolution 07-38, December 10-16, 2007. Commissioner McGavran seconded. Motion carried.

Commissioner McGavran moved to extend the disaster Resolution 07-38 for another seven days. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, discussed roads and bridges of the county.

Russ Thornton, Undersheriff, gave prisoner count of 35.
