

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M. Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McCullick.

The official minutes of September 25, 2006, were read, approved, and signed.

Tammy Schmidt, and Val Beikmann, USD #239, visited with the commissioners for support of Red Ribbon Week. They explained the programs that they are doing. Commissioner McGavran moved to give \$150 to support Red Ribbon Week, out of the Drug and Alcohol Fund. Commissioner Luthi seconded. Motion carried.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, reported that Geocore Services had performed well testing at both landfills. John gave the board a letter from the City of Salina, that effective January 1, 2007, that solid waste disposal will increase to \$28/ton.

Sandy Cline, Health/Aging Department, submitted two bids for a replacement vehicle for the Health/Aging Department. Commissioner McGavran moved to accept the bid on the Bennett Auto-plex vehicle. Commissioner Luthi seconded. Motion carried.

Harvey Henderson, Noxious Weed Administrator, was in and talked to the board on noxious weed issues.

Ken White, County Sheriff, met with the commissioners to discuss department matters. Prisoner count is 37. Ken is working on a contract with Geary County to hold inmates.

Janice Davidson, Emergency Management, was in to have the commissioners approve and sign the 2007 Emergency Management Cooperative Agreement for State and Local Assistance funds.
