8:00 a.m. Regular Session

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McCullick.

The official minutes of December 4, 2006, were read, approved, and signed.

Vouchers were approved.

Commissioner Luthi moved to appoint Tracy Turner as Lincoln Township Clerk. Commissioner McGavran seconded. Motion carried.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, reported that he was getting ready to go meet with someone in regards to a case in Topeka.
