

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, and Mary Arganbright, County Clerk.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McGavran.

The official minutes of July 26, 2010, were approved and signed.

Commissioner Luthi moved to appoint Craig Smith as the Henry Township Trustee. Commissioner Kay seconded. Motion carried.

Betty Mick, County Attorney, talked to the commissioners on an issue they have her researching.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, gave the commissioners a copy of a letter in response to a citizen's complaint on a road. John reported on what crews were doing.

Sandy Cline, Health/Aging Department, came in and gave the commissioners the Preparedness Grant to be signed.
