Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Mortimer moved to approve the 2023 Ottawa county budget. Commissioner Wolf seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioners talked with Scot Loyd about American Rescue Plan Funds and grant writing to get the most they could out of these funds and the new BIL funds available.

Scot Loyd left the meeting.

Clerk Maddox presented the commissions with invoices to approve, mail, and 2023 holiday schedule.

Commissioner Malmberg opened mail.

Minutes from August 29, 2022 were reviewed. Commissioner Malmberg moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Wolf seconded. Motion carried, 3-0.
