

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of January 28, 2008, was read, approved, and signed.

The commissioners examined and confirmed the Annual Township reports of Buckeye, Henry, Logan, Blaine, and Ottawa.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, reported on cases.

Brandon Cochran, Rescue Team, talked to the commissioners about purchasing some ice rescue suits.

Ken White, County Sheriff, gave prisoner count of 39. Ken discussed repairs on his pickup.

Glennace Kirn, and Deb Byarlay, Central Kansas Mental Health, gave the board an update on services.
