

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M. Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McCullick.

The official minutes of June 26, 2006, were read, approved, and signed.

Elaine Bowers, Candidate for 107th State Representative, stopped in and introduced herself to the board.

Abatement's were approved.

Truette McQueen, County Appraiser, came in and the commissioners talked to Truette about a taxpayer questioning the zoning and tax process, and asked for Truette to contact the individual and go through it with her.
