

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of September 10, 2007, were read, approved, and signed.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, discussed legal issues.

Sandy Cline, Health/Aging Administrator, brought in an email that she had sent to the Area Agency on Aging in reference to provide Sandy with information on the Senior Care Act. Julie Govert-Walters, Area on Aging, joined the group. Julie updated the board on the Senior Care Act, request for incentive funding. Commissioner McGavran moved to give incentive fund matching for \$2,500 to the Senior Care Act. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried.
