Commissioner Kay opened the meeting in the flag salute, and said prayer.

At 8:00 a.m., the commissioners held board of canvass for the mail ballot elections for USD #239 and USD #240, held June 24, 2014. Commissioner Luthi moved to raise election board worker wage from \$7.50 per hour to \$8.00. Commissioner Brumbaugh seconded. Motion carried. The commissioners signed Resolution 14-17, increasing election board worker wages from \$7.50 per hour to \$8.00 per hour.

Kenny Baccus, Noxious Weed Administrator, brought up chemical sales year-to-date for the commissioners to look at. Kenny discussed chemical spraying with the board.

Payroll and vouchers were approved.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, and Allen Brown, Road Foreman, met with the board and John reported on what crews were doing. John gave the board a solid waste exemption from Dwight Lister, 501 N Main, Delphos, which was denied as it is a livable residence with electricity hooked up. The group discussed speed limit signs. The group discussed the issue of switching out motor grader blades. The commissioners said they have met with the motor grader men, and their report was the men are concerned about their safety in switching out the blades, and the roads will not be graded like they are used to. Allen explained the crown process, and training that all the blade men went to. Allen discussed what he has told the blade men about helping them. After discussion it was decided to meet with the blade men July 7 at 7:00 a.m., at the count shop. The commissioners will go look at roads July 3 at 7:30 a.m.
