

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

Commissioner Kay opened the meeting in the flag salute and prayer.

The official minutes of January 23, 2012, were approved and signed.

For the record, Commissioner Luthi was attending a transportation meeting.

The commissioners examined and confirmed the annual township reports of Fountain, Stanton, Buckeye, Bennington, Ottawa, and Henry Townships.

Payroll and vouchers were approved.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, reported on what crews were doing. John asked about putting some obsolete equipment on Purple Wave auction site for sale. John said that he needs to take bids for grader blades, and also needs to replace the pneumatic roller.

Truette McQueen, County Appraiser, brought up the GIS Workshop contract for support to be signed. The commissioners signed the contract.

Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 17, Saline County 6, Ottawa County 1, and KDOC 15, with 8 more from KDOC later in the week. Keith said that the water heaters have been installed and working well. Keith discussed the narrow banding of radio's, and several repeaters that will need to be reprogrammed, that don't belong to the county.
