

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, and Mary Arganbright, County Clerk.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McGavran.

The official minutes of April 19, 2010, were approved and signed.

The commissioners signed Resolution 10-10, finding it necessary to raise election board workers pay from \$7.00 to \$7.25.

Vouchers were approved.

Commissioner Luthi moved to re-appoint Richard Darg and Pam Barker to the Hospital Board. Commissioner Kay seconded. Motion carried.

John Cople, Highway Administrator, gave the commissioners a renewal contract for the fuel tank inventory from Tank Management Services Inc., which they signed. John gave the board the permit applications from the Core of Engineers Water Resource for bridge construction at Granite and 210<sup>th</sup> Road. John said that he needs to get some prices on bridge planks. The group discussed compensation time and overtime.

Truette McQueen, County Appraiser, talked to the commissioners about Neighborhood Revitalization. The program can be amended at anytime for the county to join. Then a new interlocal agreement would need to be done. Truette said that as far as an economic development goes, a plan would need to be in place. Truette will talk to the bond attorney to make sure everyone is on the same page.

Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 27, Saline County 2, and Ottawa County 8. Keith reported on employee matters.

Rosie Walter, Community Corrections, presented FY11 KDOC Comprehensive Plan Grant Applications. The commissioners signed the grant applications.
