The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with First District Commissioner Dawn Wolf, Second District Commissioner James P. Kay, Third District Commissioner Karen S. Brumbaugh, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

Commissioner Kay opened the meeting in prayer then led the group in the flag salute.

Mary Arganbright, Ottawa County Clerk, visited with the commissioners about the annual holiday dinner. She gave the board a new employee job description to sign. Mary gave the commissioners the Lease-Purchase Agreement from BSB Capital Inc., to sign, for the two 2019 Caterpillar motor graders. The commissioners signed the agreement.
