\_\_\_\_\_ I recognize that there are criminal and civil penalties for failure to follow the rules and regulations set forth in Resolution #24-08. I understand that violation of Resolution 24-08 shall constitute a Class C non-person misdemeanor subject to a fine not to exceed \$500 and incarceration in the Ottawa County Jail for a period not to exceed 30 days. Prosecutions for violations of this Resolution shall be in the District Court of Ottawa County, Kansas, as authorized by K.S.A. 19-101(d) and amendments thereto. In addition to the aforementioned penalties the person or persons convicted of violating the provisions of Resolution 24-08 shall be liable for restitution the fire departments and other emergency personnel responding the fire and for damages caused by the fire. Any person convicted of violating the terms of this resolution shall have their Burn Registration Number revoked for a period of one year from date of conviction. For reinstatement you must produce a certificate of successful completion of Prescribed Burn School training.
