

Ottawa County Board of Commissioners

Regular Session

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m., by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of September 8, 2008, were read, approved, and signed.

Vouchers were approved.

Scott Norris, Bennington, came in and explained some documentation in regards to the road that goes by his home.

Jim Duggan, Niles, came in and talked to the board about a mosquito problem in Niles.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, and Betty Mick, Attorney-Elect, met with the commissioners, and talked on legal matters.

The commissioners signed Resolution 08-17, for the possible vacating of a Road beginning at the SE corner of Section 16, Township 10, Range 1, going North ½ mile, on 270th Road, Durham Township, Ottawa County, Kansas.

The commissioners signed Resolution 08-18, endorsing transportation improvements for Ottawa County, Kansas and the enactment by the Kansas Legislature of a new state-wide comprehensive transportation program.

Tammy Schmidt, Val Biekman, and Danielle Casey, informed the board that Red Ribbon Week is coming up. Commissioner McGavran moved to give \$200 for Red Ribbon Week. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, gave the board the renewal agreement from City of Salina for solid waste disposal. The commissioners signed the agreement. John discussed what crews were doing.

Ken White, County Sheriff, gave prisoner count of 10.

At 11:10 a.m., the commissioners adjourned to go look at fences, roads, and bridges within the county.
