

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, and Mary Arganbright, County Clerk.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McGavran.

The official minutes of September 27, 2010, were approved and signed.

Randy Dick, Kaw Valley Insurance, health insurance representative, stopped in and the commissioners went over new laws from the health care reform act, and discussed upcoming insurance quotes.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, reported on what crews were doing. John reported on interviews he did last week. John has done some checking on turning two motor graders back in on the trade program, and replacing them.

Ken Stelter, Custodian, gave the commissioners an update on courthouse matters.

Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 58, Ottawa County 5, Cloud County 1, and Saline County 1. Keith reported on employee matters. Keith said that there is going to be some speed limit changes, per KDOT, in the county. Keith talked on a couple patrol cars in the north parking lot, which one he is going to be getting rid of. Keith said he has upgraded all the officer's cell phones, as most were not working very well. The plan actually went down. Keith said that he would like to put out quotes for a new patrol car, which was approved.

The commissioners signed two solid waste exemptions for James Mills, Delphos and Delphos Coop Association, Delphos.

Sandy Cline, Health and Aging Department, gave the commissioners copies of her DOT drug & alcohol testing policy for transportation. The commissioners signed the document. Sandy said that she has decided they are going to have to postpone regional dispatch. Things are not in place yet. Sandy said they are going to do another flu clinic exercise.

Betty Mick, County Attorney, came in and the commissioners asked her about an agreement they gave her in July to look over on a request from an individual wanting on the missal base. Betty said she will have to look for it.
