The commissioners will table the decision until next week when Commissioner Luthi is back.

John Cople, Highway Administrator, reported on what crews were doing. John gave the board the information on the bridges that USD #240 Tescott reported on that RMA Engineering had looked at. John said that the bobcat lease is almost expired. He is getting new ones.

Larry Sharp, KCAMP, gave the commissioners an update on the county's liability insurance.

Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 27, Ottawa County 2, Saline County 12. Keith had quotes for three car camera's; Digital -Ally, \$8,475; Kustom Signals, Inc., \$15,081; and Watch Guard, \$14,865. The commissioners approved the purchase from Digital-Ally, \$8,475. They are going to demonstrate the camera's before Keith will commit to the purchase.
