

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Kathy M. Luthi, and Mary Arganbright, County Clerk.

The commissioners viewed an alley in Niles before official session.

Janice Davidson, Emergency Management, reported on what is going on in her office. Commissioner McGavran moved to extend the burn ban another 7 days. Commissioner Luthi seconded. Motion carried.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, continued reporting on a case. Bruce also discussed possible jury trials coming up.
