

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Harold McCullick, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of June 25, 2007, were read, approved, and signed.

David and Matt Atkinson, Lakeview, talked to the commissioners about extending the free dump at the landfill for the lake area.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, discussed legal issues.

Commissioner McCullick moved to appoint Rosemary Neaderhiser to the 28th Judicial District Community Corrections Adult and Juvenile Advisory Board to replace Scott Ausherman. Commissioner McGavran seconded. Motion carried.

Janice Davidson, Emergency Management, gave the board some donation slips for the emergency relief fund. Janice brought up the 2008 Cooperative Agreement Program Submission for Kansas Emergency Management for the commissioners to sign. The group discussed tornado related items.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, gave the commissioners a report of the tire cleanup, which was 98.53 ton collected. John said he sent out quotes for site closure of the tornado waste disposal. John gave the board a change order #4 from KDOT on the Rainbow Bridge for seed cover, and the Notice of acceptance accepting that the bridge project is completed. The commissioners signed both letters.

Sara Hodges, Ottawa County Health Planning Commission, brought in the tax credit information on the dental project. She reported they have been rewarded the full amount.

Keith Coleman, Undersheriff, gave prisoner count of 39.

Dave Wallace, Minneapolis, came in and requested an exemption on landfill charges for the Baptist Church.
