

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner Harold McCullick, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m., by Chairperson Luthi.

The official minutes of June 23, 2008, were read, approved, and signed.

Vouchers were approved.

Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, reported on office matters.

Pat Baccus, County Treasurer, brought up information on the postal presort.

Sandy Cline, Health/Aging Department, gave a report on the Hospice survey to the commissioners. Sandy discussed the transportation fee slight increase. Commissioner McGavran moved to approve the proposed transportation costs effective August 1, 2008. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, reported on what crews were doing. The commissioners received the renewal permit #0591, from KDHE for the CDL license for the period of July 1, 2008 - June 30, 3009.

Truette McQueen, County Appraiser, talked to the board about the new CAMA system, and it will be implement in August. Truette went over necessary items that will need to be purchased.

Ken White, County Sheriff, and Keith Coleman, Emergency Management, met with the commissioners. Dickinson County/FEMA have been authorized to use the emergency response trailer for their disaster. Ken gave prisoner count of 8. Commissioner McGavran moved to go into executive session at 11: 28 a.m. for fifteen minutes to discuss attorney/client matters. Commissioner McCullick seconded. Motion carried. Those present were the commissioners, Bruce Barefield, County Attorney, and Ken. They returned to regular session at 11:43 a.m. The commissioners agreed with Ken's decision for his offer of hire.
