

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Karen Brumbaugh, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

Commissioner Kay opened the meeting in the flag salute. Bruce Shields gave prayer.

Vouchers were approved.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, reported on what crews were doing. John gave the board the agreement between KDOT and Ottawa County for Project #72C-0224-13, Federal Fund Exchange Program for federal funds \$81,305.82, for one concrete box on Aspen Road, one aluminum box on Granite Road between 230th and 240th Road, and a concrete box on 110th and Limestone Road. The commissioners signed the agreement. John gave the board the list of items he planned to put on Purple Wave this week. The group discussed the Doering curve. John discussed employee matters. Mary Thrower, stopped in and reported on some musk thistles that needed to be taken care of. John said he would let Kenny Baccus, Noxious Weed Administrator, know.

Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 30, Saline County 6, Cloud County 1, and Ottawa County 4.

Chris Carlson, stopped in and asked the commissioners to look at the corner of Limestone Road and Rock St., going West, the dip in the road. The commissioners said they would view it next week.
