

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner Kathy M. Luthi, Commissioner Ray McGavran, Commissioner Harold McCullick, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman McCullick.

At 8:30 a.m. the commissioners viewed a road being proposed to be closed on the Ottawa/Saline County line.
