

The Board of Commissioners met in regular session with Commissioner James P Kay, Commissioner Kathy M Luthi, Commissioner Ray McGavran, and County Clerk Mary Arganbright.

Commissioner Kay opened the meeting in the flag salute and prayer.

The official minutes of August 29, 2011, were approved and signed.

Bob Lott, Minneapolis, came in and discussed the recycling center with the commissioners.

John Copple, Highway Administrator, reported on what crews were doing. John said that they are going to have to replace his secretary's computer. John visited with the board on the excavator.

Jeff Younger, Seminole Energy, came in and gave the commissioners the results of an estimate he did on the cost of natural gas that his company could provide. The estimate was calculated with the Courthouse and Jail accounts with Kansas Gas Service, as they are on a continuous block line, and had over 1,500 M's. The cost savings had the county been with Seminole Energy for a 18 month period would have been \$3,895.09. After further discussion, it was decided to have the county attorney look over the contract.

Keith Coleman, Sheriff, gave prisoner count of Sedgwick County 36, and Saline County 2.

Betty Mick, County Attorney, came in and went over the procedures that will need to be done on amending a couple of resolutions language on easement vacation's. She said that she is working on the matter of tax sales.
